



## Putting a PDF on to Kindle

If you know your Kindle email address just simply email the PDF file to that and 'hey presto' it's there!

Otherwise, follow these steps:

- Plug your Kindle in to your PC using the USB cable

### ***On your PC***

- Go to 'Computer' on your PC and click on Kindle (like you would if you were using a USB disk/pen)
- Once in your Kindle folder, click through the folders to the folder where your other Kindle books are
- Drag the PDF into that folder and 'bingo'!

### ***On Your Kindle***

- It should appear in your Kindle books menu straight away
- I haven't found a way that it will let you change the font size on the PDF but I changed the view to landscape which made it larger and more readable. The page is split in three to read but this didn't worry me, you just click the page turner as normal.

### **To change from 'portrait' to 'landscape' view on Kindle**

Press the 'Menu' key (2<sup>nd</sup> button in from right on basic Kindle)

Arrow down to 'Zoom and Contrast' and enter

Arrow down to 'Screen Rotation' and arrow across to the landscape option that suits you (I found the last one easiest as then the page turning click is at the bottom of the Kindle, but of course, that would be down to your own preference!)
